The **Transitions/S.T.A.R. Program** is designed to support students who may struggle in a traditional classroom setting by offering individualized instruction and one-on-one guidance. Our goal is to help students achieve their academic potential in a supportive and structured environment.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- **Full-time attendance required:** Monday – Friday
- **Monday Enrichment:** Afternoon enrichment classes available from the Day School schedule
- **Tuesday – Friday:** Students focus on cognitive training (if required) and academics
 - **Grades 2-5:** Mrs. Beminio will teach all core academics with cognitive training.
 - **Middle School:** Math instruction (Mrs. Tagliareni), core academics and cognitive (Mrs. Alvarez)
 - **High School:** Math instruction (Mrs. Tagliareni), core academics (Mr. Williams)
 - **Friday's** instruction by Mrs. Tagliareni

CURRICULUM & COGNITIVE TRAINING

- A variety of curriculum resources, including online platforms, textbooks, worksheets, and multi-sensory learning approaches
- Cognitive Training for Processing Skills: Included in tuition for grades second and up

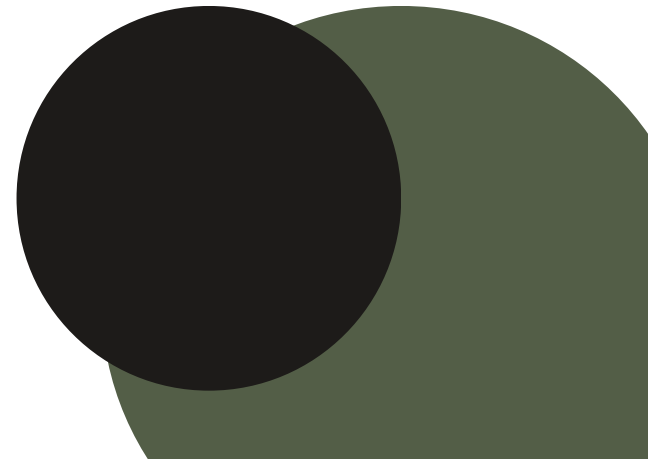
ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Students with good behavior control who struggle in traditional settings
- Must be no more than one year behind grade level
- Student-teacher ratio: 9:1
- Admission is considered based on:
 - Current IEP, academic records, testing results
 - Teacher recommendations
- We are unable to accept students on the autism spectrum, students with a matrix code of 251 or higher, or students with neurological, physical, or emotional challenges.

STEPS TO ENROLLMENT

 - Bring student records, IEP (if applicable), achievement testing, report card, and recommendation form

Transitions and S.T.A.R.-Remedial Program (6-12)

Enrollment Option: Five (5) days (M-F)

Classes are held Mondays-Thursdays 9:00-3:00 PM. Friday classes are held from 9:00-12:00.

Scholarships Accepted: FES-EO, FES-UA, FTC

Admission: This program is for students with good behavior control who struggle to learn in a traditional setting and are no more than 2-3 years behind. The program is individualized, and the student-teacher ratio is 9:1. We consider admission to this program after a thorough review of current I.E.P., academic records, testing, teacher recommendation, and approval by our S.T.A.R. teaching staff.

We only accept students who we consider a good fit for our program. We are unable to accept students within the Autistic spectrum, students with a Matrix code of 253 or higher, and students with neurological, physical, emotional, or behavioral challenges.

S.T.A.R. (Students and Teachers Achieving Results) is a five-day-a-week (34-week) program that offers an individualized learning environment for students who struggle to learn in a traditional classroom environment. S.T.A.R. students share the campus with the K-12 Day School and follow all the same procedures and policies. Please see the Day School General Information for the policies and procedures.

Therapy: Students who need therapy may be dismissed early during enrichment time for therapy, or their therapist may come on campus. Therapy fees are not included in S.T.A.R. tuition.

Curriculum: We will use a variety of curricula. The curriculum will be determined once we identify the students' actual needs in the class. We will utilize an online curriculum, textbooks, supplemental worksheets, multi-sensory, and individualized teaching. **The cost of books and materials is included in tuition. The school will order books.**
***Any Monday Elective or Day School Class Curriculum is not included in STAR book fees.**

*There is a one-time Mindprint/Brainware Fee of \$250 for Transitions students in grades 3-8.

Homework: Students should expect thirty minutes to one hour of homework daily. Parents are responsible for overseeing homework and signing the homework assignment sheet each evening.

Diploma: High school students in the S.T.A.R. program can graduate with either a regular or a career diploma if they complete the requirements. See the Day School handbook for graduation requirements. Both diploma options are accepted at colleges across the nation. A certificate of participation is available for a student who cannot complete the required credits for a diploma but has been in attendance for four years of school.

Testing: IXL is included, or you can choose to take the SAT10 for \$50.00.
