Current members who complete enrollment by February 20, 2026—including registering in Sycamore, paying half of the registration fee (with the remaining balance due by April 1), and allowing the school to set up tuition payments through their FACTS account—will qualify for current member tuition rates per student.

Champion Academy's uniform policy is designed to promote consistency, modesty, and professionalism among students. The dress code ensures that all students maintain a neat, well-groomed, and appropriate appearance without drawing unnecessary attention.

Dress Code by Day

- **Tuesday–Thursday:** Standard uniform requirements (boys and girls).
- **Monday & Friday:** Shirts and tops should be free of words or graphics, with school spirit T-shirts as the exception.
 - Bottoms can be any color with no rips, holes, or frayed edges. No pajama pants, athletic pants, or sweatpants
 - Shorts should be walking length (Bermuda).
 - Girls may wear Dresses, Skirts, or Skorts that should be walking length (Bermuda).
 - Hoodies, sweaters, and jackets must be a solid, single color with logo or without logo. Outerwear may not display graphics; only small brand logos are permitted.
 - All other guidelines from the Tuesday–Thursday dress code still applies.

Boys' Uniform Requirements

- Bottoms: Solid navy, khaki, black pants, joggers, or walking-length shorts (e.g., Bermuda).
 - No pajama pants, athletic pants, or sweatpants.
- Tops & Outerwear: Solid-colored polo shirts with the school's embroidered logo are required. Solid, single-colored hoodies and jackets may be worn with or without the school logo. Outerwear may not display graphics; only small brand logos are permitted.
- Footwear: Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes (athletic shoes preferred).
 - Ankle or no-show socks are preferred.

Additional Guidelines for Boys

1. Clothing must fit properly.
2. Pre-existing tattoos must be covered.
3. Hair must be well-groomed, naturally colored, and free of extreme styles (e.g., Mohawks).
 - Facial hair is not permitted.
4. Jewelry limited to one necklace and one bracelet or watch.
 - No smartwatches.
5. Clothing that is too tight, too baggy, ripped, torn, or frayed is not allowed.
6. Earrings or other piercings are not permitted.

7. Caps, hats, bandanas, and scarves are not allowed in school.

Girls' Uniform Requirements

- Bottoms: Solid navy, khaki, or black pants, capris, shorts, skirts, or skorts.
 - Shorts, skirts, and skorts must be no more than 4 inches above the knee.
 - No pajama pants, athletic pants, sweatpants, stand-alone leggings or yoga pants.
- Tops & Outerwear: Solid-colored polo shirts with the school's embroidered logo are required. Solid single-colored hoodies and jackets may be worn with or without the school logo. Outerwear may not display graphics; only small brand logos are permitted.
- Footwear: Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes (athletic shoes preferred).
 - Heels must not exceed 1 inch.
 - Ankle or no-show socks are preferred.

Additional Guidelines for Girls

1. Clothing must fit properly.
2. Pre-existing tattoos must be covered.
3. Upper-school girls may wear conservative-colored nail polish and light makeup.
4. Hair must be well-groomed, naturally colored, and free of extreme styles (e.g., Mohawks).
5. Jewelry limited to one necklace, one bracelet or watch, and one pair of small earrings. (Other piercings are not permitted).
 - No smartwatches or hoop earrings.
6. Skirts/skorts must be worn with solid navy, tan, or black biker/slider shorts underneath.
7. Leggings and biker shorts may not be worn as standalone bottoms.
8. Clothing that is too tight, too baggy, immodest (low-cut necklines, sheer fabric, off-the-shoulder, bare midriff, or short skirts), or damaged (ripped, torn, frayed) is not permitted.
9. Caps, hats, bandanas, and scarves are not allowed in school.

Cold Weather Allowance (Applies on days when temperatures are below 40°F and are not expected to rise above 55°F during the school day.)

- Students may wear a winter coat in addition to their Champion uniform shirt.
- Jeans may replace uniform pants.
- Layers may be added for warmth.
- Solid, single-colored hoodies, coats, and jackets may be worn with or without the school logo. Outerwear may not display graphics; only small brand logos are permitted.
- Solid-colored long-sleeve undershirts may be worn underneath uniform shirts.
- Boots may be worn in cold weather
